

OGSD School Board Meeting – May 1, 2019

The Oro Grande School District held its monthly School Board meeting the evening of Wednesday, May 1, and approved several items affecting students, faculty and parents, including:

- Approving resolutions recognizing National Charter Schools Week, School Lunch Hero Day, Classified School Employee Week, Asian Pacific American Heritage Month, Teacher Appreciation Week and National Police Week and Peace Officers Memorial Day.
- Ratifying a contract for the installation of two new HVAC units and associated structural work for the Riverside Prep Gymnasium.
- Approving OGSD entering a Memorandum of Understanding with Victor Valley College for the College and Careers Access Pathways (CCAP) Agreement for eligible students for the 2019-20 and 2020-21 school years.
- Approving revisions to the 2019-20 school calendar for Oro Grande Elementary and Riverside Preparatory School

Additionally, at the start of the meeting high school and middle schools students delivered presentations on the new SHIELD (Students Helping to Innovate Education through Leadership Development) and SLED (Students Leading Education) programs. The students explained the purpose of the programs and some of the goals and projects they plan to work on next school year.
